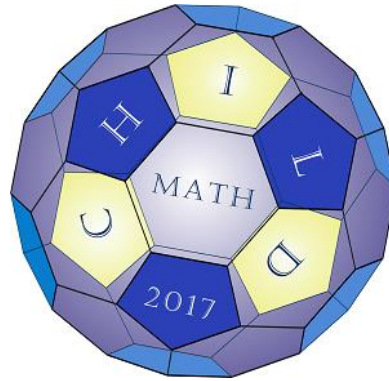


**FIRST CALL FOR
